The Part 1 Test allows the candidate

60 minutes to answer 100 true or false questions	
30 minutes to answer 50 multiple choice questions	

The Part 2 Test requires the candidate to obtain

A high standard of driving for a period of 30 minutes	
No more than 6 minor errors during a period of 60 minutes	
No serious errors during a 60 minute period	

The Part 3 Test requires the candidate to

Teach the examiner acting as a learner driver	
Assess the examiners own driving	
Teach the learner one of the set exercises
